### Spellings

rhythm	James plays <b>rhythm</b> guitar.
purpose	I will reject these goods as unfit for <b>purpose</b> .
problem	Do not confound the <b>problem</b> by losing your temper.
he's	A conceited man thinks <b>he's</b> the best.
his	A proficient person does <b>his</b> job well.
personification	Giving an object human qualities is <b>personification</b> - 'a strong wind menaced the trees'.
address	<b>Address</b> the judge as 'Your Honour'.
perspective	Focalisation is when the narrative particularly follows and gives the <b>perspective</b> of a single character (or perhaps a single group of characters).
dangerous	Chlorine gas is very <b>dangerous</b> .
Wordsworth	<b>Wordsworth</b> wrote the poem 'Daffodils'.
