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| alliteration | Alliteration involves words that begin with the same sound. |
| simile | Simile involves describing something by comparing it with something else. |
| metaphor | A metaphor is an image containing a strong comparison. For example, the moon is a piece of cheese. |
| assonance | Assonance involves words that have the same vowel sound. |
| stanza | A stanza is a verse of a poem. |
| rhyme | Time, crime and chime all rhyme . |
| rhythm | James plays rhythm guitar. |
| repetition | When words or phrases are repeated for effect we call it repetition . |
