

## Spelling list: Literary terms

alliteration	<b>Alliteration</b> involves words that begin with the same sound.
simile	<b>Simile</b> involves describing something by comparing it with something else.
metaphor	A <b>metaphor</b> is an image containing a strong comparison. For example, the moon is a piece of cheese.
assonance	<b>Assonance</b> involves words that have the same vowel sound.
stanza	A <b>stanza</b> is a verse of a poem.
rhyme	Time, crime and chime all <b>rhyme</b> .
rhythm	James plays <b>rhythm</b> guitar.
repetition	When words or phrases are repeated for effect we call it <b>repetition</b> .
