Spelling list: Literary terms

alliteration Alliteration involves words that begin with the same sound.

simile Simile involves describing something by comparing it with something else.

A **metaphor** is an image containing a strong comparison. For example, the

metaphor moon is a piece of cheese.

assonance Assonance involves words that have the same vowel sound.

stanza A **stanza** is a verse of a poem.

rhyme Time, crime and chime all **rhyme** .

rhythm James plays **rhythm** guitar.

repetition When words or phrases are repeated for effect we call it **repetition**.
