Suffix -ed is added to the end of a word to show the past tense and can make 3 sounds: (id), (d) and (t)

handed	Mrs Wells handed out iPads to her Class.
mended	An electrician mended my lights.
intended	Greg intended to catch the 11:00 O'Clock train.
stayed	Because of the storm all the boats stayed in port.
scared	She was scared of the dark.
stopped	Sophie stopped at the Post Office to buy some sweets on the way home.
dropped	Whilst eating a meal, he dropped a noodle.
splashed	Jack splashed water on his face to cool down.
escaped	They searched for the escaped prisoner.
