

## Spelling list: -ed

Suffix -ed is added to the end of a word to show the past tense and can make 3 sounds: (id), (d) and (t)

planted	Mrs Smith <b>planted</b> the cabbages in a neat row.
handed	Mrs Wells <b>handed</b> out iPads to her Class.
mended	An electrician <b>mended</b> my lights.
intended	Greg <b>intended</b> to catch the 11:00 O'Clock train.
stayed	Because of the storm all the boats <b>stayed</b> in port.
scared	She was <b>scared</b> of the dark.
stopped	Sophie <b>stopped</b> at the Post Office to buy some sweets on the way home.
dropped	Whilst eating a meal, he <b>dropped</b> a noodle.
splashed	Jack <b>splashed</b> water on his face to cool down.
escaped	They searched for the <b>escaped</b> prisoner.
