Suffix -ed is added to the end of a word to show the past tense and can make 3 sounds: (id), (d) and (t)

planted Mrs Smith **planted** the cabbages in a neat row.

handed Mrs Wells **handed** out iPads to her Class.

mended An electrician **mended** my lights.

intended Greg **intended** to catch the 11:00 O'Clock train.

stayed Because of the storm all the boats **stayed** in port.

scared She was **scared** of the dark.

stopped Sophie **stopped** at the Post Office to buy some sweets on the way home.

dropped Whilst eating a meal, he **dropped** a noodle.

splashed Jack **splashed** water on his face to cool down.

escaped They searched for the **escaped** prisoner.
