

## Spelling list: -ly words plus 4 high frequency words.

- ly is a consonant suffix which is added to the end of words. If the word ends in a y, change the y to an i and add -ly."

swiftly	<b>Swiftly</b> , the fox gathered speed to escape from the hounds.
quickly	Our baby has grown so <b>quickly</b> .

unfriendly	He looked very <b>unfriendly</b> but was just shy!
briskly	<b>Briskly</b> , I hurried along the slippery, frozen pathway to my home.
strictly	The end of year Prom is <b>strictly</b> Year 11 only.
softly	The orchestra played <b>softly</b> in the background.
loudly	Shaun snores very <b>loudly</b> .
slowly	The river flows <b>slowly</b> here.
angry	It's plain to see you are <b>angry</b> .
angrily	This is totally karma, she told herself <b>angrily</b> .
bravely	<b>Bravely</b> , she sat in the doctors.
amazingly	The gadget was <b>amazingly</b> cool.
excitedly	<b>Excitedly</b> , the boys rushed downstairs on Christmas morning.
heard	I <b>heard</b> a very weird noise in the night.
everywhere	The glitter got <b>everywhere</b> .
enough	A dozen eggs will be <b>enough</b> .
