Adding suffixes beginning with a vowel to words with more than one syllable.

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| forgetting | She is always forgetting where she has put her keys. |
| forgotten | You might have forgotten . |
| beginning | My hair is beginning to go grey. |
| beginner | She has just started playing the guitar - she is a beginner . |
| preferred | She preferred cake to pudding. |
| preferring | Preferring to eat earlier rather than later, I booked a table for 5.30pm. |
| occurred | A scene in a story that occurred before the present time in the story. |
| occurring | Physical features are naturally occurring . |
| forbidden | It is illegal to smuggle forbidden goods. |
| committed | Henry committed a serious crime - he forgot to say thank you! |
