Words ending in the long o sound and -ld or -st. A Mnemonic sentence to help remember the rule for -old is oh, you lucky duck.

gold	The king wears a <b>gold</b> crown.
cold	David has a bad <b>cold</b> and a cough.
hold	<b>Hold</b> the reins lightly.
sold	We <b>sold</b> our house in less than a week.
told	I <b>told</b> you to be quiet.
ghost	Spectre is another word for <b>ghost</b> .
most	<b>Most</b> chairs and tables are made of wood.
post	Wind the rope around the <b>post</b> .
old	The ceiling is very low in this <b>old</b> house.
bold	Click B to change the text to <b>bold</b> .
fold	<b>Fold</b> your clothes before you pack them.
host	The consensus is that we should <b>host</b> the 2011 Teen Pageant at the Montserrat Cultural Centre.
