Words ending in the long o sound and -ld or -st. A Mnemonic sentence to help remember the rule for -old is oh, you lucky duck.

gold                    The king wears a **gold** crown.

cold                    David has a bad **cold** and a cough.

hold                    **Hold** the reins lightly.

sold                    We **sold** our house in less than a week.

told                    I **told** you to be quiet.

ghost                   Spectre is another word for **ghost** .

most                   **Most** chairs and tables are made of wood.

post                    Wind the rope around the **post** .

old                    The ceiling is very low in this **old** house.

bold                    Click B to change the text to **bold** .

fold                    **Fold** your clothes before you pack them.

host                    The consensus is that we should **host** the 2011 Teen Pageant at the Montserrat Cultural Centre.
