

## Spelling list: Poetry Terminology (copy)

List of words commonly used in poetry essays

onomatopoeia	<b>Onomatopoeia</b> is when the sound of a word is the same as its meaning.
metaphor	Symbolism is an art style which uses mythology and <b>metaphor</b> to convey ideas.
simile	<b>Simile</b> involves describing something by comparing it with something else.
adjective	An <b>adjective</b> is a word which describes something.
enjambment	A poet uses <b>enjambment</b> to flow from one line to the next without punctuation.
stanza	A poem has a minimum of one <b>stanza</b> .
emotive	<b>Emotive</b> language provokes an emotional reaction from the audience.
emphasise	Words which <b>emphasise</b> an adjective, verb or adverb e.g. really, very.
technique	We all admired the wood-carver's <b>technique</b> .
imagery	<b>Imagery</b> is when words are used to create a picture in a reader's mind.
repetition	When words or phrases are repeated for effect we call it <b>repetition</b> .
language	The TV censor cut out the bad <b>language</b> .
rhythm	James plays <b>rhythm</b> guitar.
connotation	The <b>connotation</b> of the message was very clear.
