Words that double the final consonant before adding ing suffix

beginning	My hair is <b>beginning</b> to go grey.
chatting	The teacher had to ask the children to stop <b>chatting</b> .
clapping	Flamenco is a Spanish dance with stamping and <b>clapping</b> .
dragging	The boy kept <b>dragging</b> his bag through the mud.
shrugging	The lady was <b>shrugging</b> her shoulders.
swimming	In my leisure time I enjoy <b>swimming</b> .
winning	The <b>winning</b> team were triumphant.
humming	The old lady was <b>humming</b> quietly.
planning	We are <b>planning</b> a picnic.
trotting	She was <b>trotting</b> on the horse.
dragging	She was <b>dragging</b> the brush through her hair.
flapping	Stop <b>flapping</b> that paper at me.
spinning	The children were <b>spinning</b> around and around.
slipping	The children are <b>slipping</b> on the icy pavement.
cutting	The barber preferred <b>cutting</b> short hairstyles.
