

Spelling list: First Form Poetry Terms

alliteration	Alliteration is the occurrence of the same letter or sound at the beginning of closely connected words.
image	An image is a picture placed in the mind from a few words or a sentence.
line	A line is a horizontal row of written words.
metaphor	A metaphor is a thing regarded as representative or symbolic of something else.
personification	Personification is the attribution of a personal nature or human characteristics to something non-human.
poem	A poem is a piece of writing which expresses feelings and ideas.
rhyme	A rhyme is a word that has the same sound as another.
rhythm	Rhythm in a poem is a strong, regular repeated pattern.
simile	Simile is a figure of speech involving the comparison of one thing with another thing of a different kind.
stanza	A stanza is a group of lines forming the basic recurring metrical unit in a poem.
syllable	A word is divided into syllables.
tone	Modulation of the voice expressing a particular feeling or mood is the tone of a poem.
verse	Another name for a stanza is a verse .
