Vocabulary to help students learning English understand various parts of grammar.

adjective	An <b>adjective</b> is a word which describes a noun.
auxiliary	The primary <b>auxiliary</b> verbs in English are to be, to have and to do.
conjunction	A <b>conjunction</b> is used to join two parts of a sentence together.
modal	A <b>modal</b> verb is a type of auxiliary verb that is used to indicate the likelihood or probability of something occurring.
phrasal	A <b>phrasal</b> verb consists of a noun and a particle.
preposition	A <b>preposition</b> combines with a pronoun or a noun to indicate location, movement or time.
rhetorical	A <b>rhetorical</b> device, such as a question, is used for effect rather than to get an answer.
syntax	The sequence in which words are put together to form sentences is known as the <b>syntax</b> .
