

## Spelling list: Prefix 'ill'

When added to a root word starting with "l", "in" becomes "il" giving a double "l" (ll)

illegal                    The traffic warden gave me a ticket for **illegal** parking.

illegible                 Her handwriting was nearly **illegible** .

illiterate                 An **illiterate** person cannot read or write.

illogical                 Irrational means **illogical** or lacking in reason.
