genre	<b>Genre</b> is the different kinds of writing for a particular purpose; for example, thriller, romance, novel, poetry.
metaphor	Symbolism is an art style which uses mythology and <b>metaphor</b> to convey ideas.
simile	<b>Simile</b> involves describing something by comparing it with something else.
opinion	To be objective is to give an <b>opinion</b> not based on personal feeling but on fact.
sibilance	The repetition of an 's' sound is called <b>sibilance</b> .
imagery	<b>Imagery</b> is when words are used to create a picture in a reader's mind.
rhetorical	A <b>rhetorical</b> device, such as a question, is used for effect rather than to get an answer.
implies	The word 'democracy' <b>implies</b> that the people enjoy civil liberties.
superlative	<b>Superlative</b> is saying something is the best, worst, most or least, for example.
