Shakespeare	<b>Shakespeare</b> uses Macbeth's soliloquy to show that he is unsure about what to do.
soliloquy	Shakespeare uses Macbeth's <b>soliloquy</b> to show that he is unsure about what to do.
dramatic	The actor made a <b>dramatic</b> speech.
irony	<b>Irony</b> is the use of words where the real meaning is the opposite of what is actually said.
tragedy	Her sudden death was a great <b>tragedy</b> .
hero	Duncan thought Macbeth was a <b>hero</b> .
warrior	The <b>warrior</b> carried a shield.
violent	Macbeth became a <b>violent</b> man, killing anyone who stood in his way.
metaphor	Symbolism is an art style which uses mythology and <b>metaphor</b> to convey ideas.
simile	<b>Simile</b> involves describing something by comparing it with something else.
persuasion	She needed all her powers of <b>persuasion</b> to get him to agree with her.
superstition	Bad luck from walking under ladders is a <b>superstition</b> .
