

## Spelling list: Using 'et' to spell the /ay/ sound

These French words are now common as part of the English language. Here, 'et' is used to spell the long /ay/ sound:

ballet	<b>Ballet</b> dancers practise for hours a day.
beret	He wears a badge on his <b>beret</b> .
bouquet	Mum said that the <b>bouquet</b> of flowers was the prettiest she had ever seen.
buffet	A <b>buffet</b> lunch will be served at noon.
cabaret	There will be a <b>cabaret</b> after dinner.
chalet	The skiers have rented a <b>chalet</b> .
crochet	Grandma will <b>crochet</b> a shawl for the baby.
duvet	This <b>duvet</b> is too warm for hot weather.
ricochet	His bullet wound came from a <b>ricochet</b> .
