

Spelling list: Revision of -le Words

le is the most common way of making the l sound at the end of words.

invisible	The hills were invisible in the thick mist.

impossible	It's impossible to hear you.
principle	It is my principle to behave honestly.
probable	Probable means likely to be true.
simple	Style is the vocabulary and language used; for example, formal or informal language, simple or complicated vocabulary.
single	I don't believe a single word you said.
uncle	Uncle Bill is my closest relative.
buckle	Most belts tie with a buckle .
