KS 3 poetry vocabulary

imagery	<b>Imagery</b> is when words are used to create a picture in a reader's mind.
sonnet	A <b>sonnet</b> is a love poem of 14 lines.
assonance	<b>Assonance</b> involves words that have the same vowel sound.
couplet	A <b>couplet</b> is a pair of lines of metre of a poem.
repetition	When words or phrases are repeated for effect we call it <b>repetition</b> .
mood	After the argument, he was in a terrible <b>mood</b> .
theme	The 'theme' is an idea or subject that recurs in a work of art or literature.
technique	We all admired the wood-carver's <b>technique</b> .
limerick	A <b>limerick</b> is a form of poetry with a strict rhyme scheme (AABBA)and often humorous.
riddle	A <b>riddle</b> is a type of word puzzle.
syllable	A <b>syllable</b> is a beat in a word.
enjambment	<b>Enjambment</b> means to continue on a sentence on across two or more lines of poetry.
acrostic	An <b>acrostic</b> poem is when the first letter, syllable or word spells out a word.
haiku	A <b>haiku</b> is a short type of Japanese poem with only three lines.
