KS 3 poetry vocabulary

imagery	Imagery is when words are used to create a picture in a reader's mind.
sonnet	A sonnet is a love poem of 14 lines.
assonance	Assonance involves words that have the same vowel sound.
couplet	A couplet is a pair of lines of metre of a poem.
repetition	When words or phrases are repeated for effect we call it repetition .
mood	After the argument, he was in a terrible mood .
theme	The 'theme' is an idea or subject that recurs in a work of art or literature.
technique	We all admired the wood-carver's technique .
limerick	A limerick is a form of poetry with a strict rhyme scheme (AABBA)and often humorous.
riddle	A riddle is a type of word puzzle.
syllable	A syllable is a beat in a word.
enjambment	Enjambment means to continue on a sentence on across two or more lines of poetry.
acrostic	An acrostic poem is when the first letter, syllable or word spells out a word.
haiku	A haiku is a short type of Japanese poem with only three lines.
