Spelling list: Doubling consonants or not! (copy)

If the last syllable of a word is stressed and ends with one consonant letter which has just one vowel letter before it, the final consonant letter is doubled before any ending with a vowel letter is added. The consonant letter is not doubled if the syllable is unstressed.

forgotten You might have **forgotten**.

forgetting Do you ever feel like you're **forgetting** something?

beginning My hair is **beginning** to go grey.

beginner She was an absolute **beginner** at the piano.

prefer Kids **prefer** to wear casual clothes.

preferred She **preferred** cake to pudding.

limiting Have you tried **limiting** your time spent on the computer?

limited His understanding of geography was **limited** .

limitation The teacher set a **limitation** on the word-count.

bury My dog likes to **bury** bones.

berry The holly **berry** is bright red.

accept l accept your apology.

except I'll eat anything **except** bananas.
