This word list focuses on initial consonant blends. An initial consonant blend occurs when two consonants are combined at the beginning of a word to create a specific sound. Each example will show you how these blends are used in simple sentences, while helping you learn and understand new words.

stop	We couldn't stop laughing.
spin	We watched the spider spin its web.
snip	She took a moment to snip the loose threads from the hem of the dress.
snap	Even though he was frustrated, he tried not to snap .
crop	The farmer was growing a crop of wheat.
step	She took a step toward him.
stag	The stag has big antlers.
stem	I trimmed the flower's stem .
