

## Spelling list: Final consonant blends - set 1

A final consonant blend consists of two or more consonants at the end of a word, like *nt* in *tent* . These words will help learners recognise and practise final consonant blends, perfect for developing phonetic skills and improving spelling accuracy. Explore the list below to enhance vocabulary with practical examples.

tent	Have you ever slept in a <b>tent</b> ?
pond	The frog is in the <b>pond</b> .
mint	<b>Mint</b> grows in the allotment.
mist	The hills were invisible in the thick <b>mist</b> .
fist	He clenched his hand in a <b>fist</b> .
pump	We need to <b>pump</b> the car tyres.
desk	The papers are on the <b>desk</b> .
milk	She poured <b>milk</b> from the jug.
