

## Spelling list: Initial and final consonant blends - set 1

Let's make things a little more difficult! The spellings in this list contain consonant blends at both the beginning and the end. Remember: a consonant blend is when two or more consonants appear together to create a new sound, like *st-* and *-mp* in *stamp* .

stamp	This envelope needs a <b>stamp</b> .
blond	He had curly <b>blond</b> hair.
clamp	They fixed a <b>clamp</b> on the wheel of the car.
flask	This <b>flask</b> holds one litre of juice.
plant	My cactus is my favourite <b>plant</b> .
stump	When the tree was cut down a <b>stump</b> was left behind.
trunk	The <b>trunk</b> of the old tree was gnarled.
drank	They <b>drank</b> and ate with merriment.
