Are you ready for more words with consonant blends at both the beginning and the end? Don't forget, a consonant blend is a sound that's created when two or more consonant sounds are merged together. For example: *sc-* and *-lp* in *scalp*.

| slept | At night we slept in the sleeping bags. |
| drink | She likes to drink lemonade. |
| strap | A rein is a strap used to lead a horse. |
| scrub | She used a sugar scrub to exfoliate. |
