

## Spelling list: Initial and final consonant blends - set 3

Test yourself on these spellings with consonant blends at both the beginning and the end! A consonant blend occurs when two consonants come together to make a new sound, like *bl-* and *-nk* in *blink* . How many can you spell correctly?

blink	The bright light made me <b>blink</b> .
frost	The <b>frost</b> glistened on the spider's web.
twist	You need to <b>twist</b> the lid.
frank	She tried to be <b>frank</b> when giving her opinion.
grand	The house was extremely <b>grand</b> .
swept	An icy draught <b>swept</b> through the street.
scrap	We used <b>scrap</b> paper to make art.
strip	The light in the garage is a fluorescent <b>strip</b> .
