

## Spelling list: Two syllable words - set 1

A two syllable word is a word you can split into two simple parts or beats. Each part has its own vowel sound. For instance, *robin* can be divided into *rob* and *in* .

robin	The <b>robin</b> sat on the snowy fence.
cabin	The <b>cabin</b> on the ship was very small.
solid	This floor is very <b>solid</b> .
habit	It is a good <b>habit</b> to brush your teeth before you go to bed.
comic	The film was full of <b>comic</b> moments.
exit	The <b>exit</b> is over there.
toxic	This fungus is <b>toxic</b> .
exam	He made a correction to his <b>exam</b> paper.
