

## Spelling list: Two syllable words - set 2

Two-syllable words are words that can be separated into two easy segments or beats. Each segment contains its own vowel sound. For instance, *denim* divides into *den* and *im* .

denim	Her handbag is made of <b>denim</b> .
panic	If she gets lost she will <b>panic</b> .
timid	The puppy was very <b>timid</b> .
visit	Did you see a kangaroo during your <b>visit</b> to Australia?
picnic	The drinks are in the <b>picnic</b> box.
cactus	You can prick your skin on a <b>cactus</b> .
public	That man will not let the <b>public</b> go on his land.
infect	A bad cut can <b>infect</b> your leg.
