

Spelling list: Two syllable words - set 5

Learning two-syllable words means splitting them into two distinct parts or beats. Each part has a unique vowel sound. For example, *dentist* breaks down into *dent* and *ist* .

dentist	The dentist examined the child's teeth.
clinic	She had an appointment at the antenatal clinic .
exact	She wasn't sure of the exact number of people who would be attending the party.
frantic	His shouts grew frantic .
contact	She left her contact number at the reception.
insist	I insist it is my turn to pay.
edit	A publisher will edit a book before printing it.
invent	The child wished someone would invent a flying car.
