Learning two-syllable words means splitting them into two distinct parts or beats. Each part has a unique vowel sound. For example, *dentist* breaks down into *dent* and *ist*.

dentist The **dentist** examined the child's teeth.

clinic She had an appointment at the antenatal **clinic**.

She wasn't sure of the exact number of people who would be attending the

party.

frantic His shouts grew frantic.

contact She left her **contact** number at the reception.

insist I **insist** it is my turn to pay.

edit A publisher will **edit** a book before printing it.

invent The child wished someone would **invent** a flying car.
