

## Spelling list: Two syllable words - set 5

Learning two-syllable words means splitting them into two distinct parts or beats. Each part has a unique vowel sound. For example, *dentist* breaks down into *dent* and *ist* .

dentist	The <b>dentist</b> examined the child's teeth.
clinic	She had an appointment at the antenatal <b>clinic</b> .
exact	She wasn't sure of the <b>exact</b> number of people who would be attending the party.
frantic	His shouts grew <b>frantic</b> .
contact	She left her <b>contact</b> number at the reception.
insist	I <b>insist</b> it is my turn to pay.
edit	A publisher will <b>edit</b> a book before printing it.
invent	The child wished someone would <b>invent</b> a flying car.
