

## Spelling list: Two syllable words - set 6

Two-syllable words are words you can break into two simple segments or beats. Each segment includes a vowel sound. For instance, *zigzag* separates into *zig* and *zag* .

zigzag	I drew a <b>zigzag</b> pattern in my notebook.
inject	Her joke would <b>inject</b> some humour into the conversation.
inspect	Make sure you <b>inspect</b> the potatoes for dirt before cooking them.
object	A tube shaped <b>object</b> is a cylinder.
expect	I <b>expect</b> you will do well in this test.
expand	Some metals <b>expand</b> when heated.
extend	We will apply for permission to <b>extend</b> our house.
splendid	We shared a <b>splendid</b> feast.
