direct	Direct speech involves the narrator giving the exact words spoken (or thought) by the character, almost always enclosed in speech marks, and often (but not always) with a reporting clause (such as 'said Jim').
address	What is your new home address ?
alliteration	Words that begin with the same sound 'but a better butter makes a batter better'.
anecdote	Much to my amusement, he told a funny anecdote.
opinion	In my opinion dogs are more friendly than cats.
rhetorical	A rhetorical figure embodying a seeming contradiction that is nonetheless true.
question	He was reluctant to answer my question .
statistics	Data to prove a fact, such as % or numbers are statistics .
triplets	A set of three words used to convey an image eg cold tired and hungry.
