invite	<b>Invite</b> means to ask someone to come somewhere with you.
contact	<b>Contact</b> is a verb that means to speak to someone. It can be by phone, email, text message or letter.
email	An <b>email</b> is a text you write to someone using a computer.
punctuation	Comma, full stop, question mark and exclamation marks are types of <b>punctuation</b> .

advert	An <b>advert</b> is a type of text used to sell or advertise something.
opposite	<b>Opposite</b> is a preposition meaning on the other side.
leisure	<b>Leisure</b> is another word for free time.
college	<b>College</b> is a place where people go to study further education.
when	<b>When</b> is a question word used to ask about a time.
