menu	A <b>menu</b> is a text where you can read food and drink choices and see the prices.
describe	When the purpose of text is to <b>describe</b> , you will see lots of adjectives that tell you what a place or person is like.
instruct	When the purpose of text is to <b>instruct</b> , it will tell you step-by-step what to do.
sell	When the purpose of text is to <b>sell</b> , it will make you want to buy something and will normally tell you how much it will cost.
sign	A <b>sign</b> is an image that gives information.
map	A map is an image that shows you where to go.
timetable	A <b>timetable</b> is a text that tells you what days you need to be here, where to go and what you are doing.
inform	When the purpose of text is to <b>inform</b> , it gives you lots of information.
entertain	When the purpose of text is to <b>entertain</b> , it is written to make you smile or interest you.
advertise	When the purpose of text is to <b>advertise</b> , it makes you want to buy something or go somewhere.
recipe	A <b>recipe</b> is a text that tells you what ingredients you need and how to make something.
ingredients	Ingredients are the individual foods and spices that make a meal.
imperative	Imperative verbs are used in instructions that tell you what to do.
sequence	First, after, next, then are examples of <b>sequence</b> words. They tell you the order that things happen in.

When the purpose of text is to **warn** you, it tells you there is danger and you need to be careful.
