airplane	You travel to other countries in the sky in an airplane .
bicycle	You ride a bicycle to college. It has 2 wheels.
timetable	We use our timetable to help us remember the lessons for the day.
taxi	You can travel in a taxi . You pay the driver to take you places in the car.
walk	It is more healthy to walk than it is to drive.
arrive	When you get to a place, we say you arrive .
depart	When you leave a place, we say you depart .
check-in	When to get to an airport or a hotel you need to check-in to let them know you have arrived.
motorbike	It is quite dangerous to ride a motorbike . It is a bike with an engine.
train	The train travels on rails. You need to go to the station and wait at the platform.
journey	You go from one place to another, this is called a journey .
ticket	You need a ticket to travel by airplane, bus or train.
travel	The verb we use to talk about going from one place to another is travel .
station	To travel by train or bus you need to go to the station .
single	A single ticket will take you to a place but not back.
return	A return ticket will take you to a place and back again.
