

## Spelling list: 05 Houses and Furniture

furniture	Things in your home are called <b>furniture</b> .
house	You live in a <b>house</b> .
home	You can say go to your house, or go <b>home</b> .
flat	You live in a block of flats. You live in a <b>flat</b> .
bathroom	The room where you shower and brush your teeth is called a <b>bathroom</b> .
garage	The room where you keep your car is called a <b>garage</b> .
toilet	In public spaces there are male and female toilets. At home you may only have one <b>toilet</b> to share.
garden	The green space outside your house is called the <b>garden</b> .
bedroom	The room where you sleep is called a <b>bedroom</b> .
stairs	To go up or down a floor in your house you use the <b>stairs</b> .
ceiling	The surface above your head in your home is called a <b>ceiling</b> .
cupboard	In the kitchen, you put plates, cups and bowls in a <b>cupboard</b> , to make it look clean and tidy.
fridge	To keep food and drink cold you use a <b>fridge</b> .
shelf	Flowers and photographs are put on a <b>shelf</b> so that people can see them.
drawers	Keep things in <b>drawers</b> to keep the home tidy. Open and close the <b>drawers</b> to take things out and put things in.
wardrobe	Clothes are usually kept in a <b>wardrobe</b> in your bedroom.
carpet	The soft surface on the floor is called a <b>carpet</b> .
