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| irregular | Irregular shapes have sides of unequal length. |
| rhombus | A Rhombus has four sides of equal length but no right angles. |
| rotate | Let us rotate the wheel. |
| rotation | Rotation is where you twist or turn something round. |
| square | A square is a shape with four equal straight sides and four right angles. |
| subtraction | We also did lots of mental subtraction and addition. |
| symmetry | Line symmetry is when a line drawn through a shape leaves each side a mirror image of the other. |
| symmetrical | To be symmetrical is when one shape becomes exactly like another if you flip, slide or turn it. |
| triangle | Draw a triangle with three equal sides. |
| triangular | The village green is triangular in shape. |
| tonne | A tonne is 1,000 kilograms. |
| vertex | The two lines meet, creating a vertex . |
| vertices | The two types of principal vertices are called 'ears' and 'mouths'. |
| vertical | A vertical cliff is a precipice. |
| volume | Volume is usually measured in cubic centimeters. |
| weight | To win the cake you must guess its weight . |
