irregular	Irregular shapes have sides of unequal length.
rhombus	A Rhombus has four sides of equal length but no right angles.
rotate	Let us rotate the wheel.
rotation	Rotation is where you twist or turn something round.
square	A square is a shape with four equal straight sides and four right angles.
subtraction	We also did lots of mental subtraction and addition.
symmetry	Line symmetry is when a line drawn through a shape leaves each side a mirror image of the other.
symmetrical	To be symmetrical is when one shape becomes exactly like another if you flip, slide or turn it.
triangle	Draw a triangle with three equal sides.
triangular	The village green is triangular in shape.
tonne	A tonne is 1,000 kilograms.
vertex	The two lines meet, creating a vertex .
vertices	The two types of principal vertices are called 'ears' and 'mouths'.
vertical	A vertical cliff is a precipice.
volume	Volume is usually measured in cubic centimeters.
weight	To win the cake you must guess its weight .
