

## Spelling list: ou words

The sound /ou/ as in *out* , at the beginning or in the middle of a word, is often spelled with the letters *ou* . The only two cases where the *ou* sound is spelled with the letters *ou* at the end of the word are *thou* and *miaou* . This list looks at a few *ou* words.

loud	The baby gave a <b>loud</b> wail.
proud	Dad was very <b>proud</b> when I won first prize.
noun	A <b>noun</b> is a word that names someone or something.
sour	Lemons have a <b>sour</b> taste.
shout	You'll need to <b>shout</b> to make him hear.
bound	He's <b>bound</b> to want to come to the party.
found	Protein is <b>found</b> in meat, fish and cheese.
ground	The earthquake made the <b>ground</b> shake.
pound	One British <b>pound</b> is worth more than one US dollar.
round	To sail <b>round</b> the world is a great feat.
sound	Click the icon to mute the <b>sound</b> .
house	Jim drew us a plan of his new <b>house</b> .
mouth	Don't talk with your <b>mouth</b> full.
couch	They sat on the <b>couch</b> together.
