On the end of a word the most common way to spell the long /a/ sound is with the letters ay .

may	Please <b>may</b> I have a piece of cake?
pay	I insist it is my turn to <b>pay</b> .

way	He looked at me in a very odd <b>way</b> .
clay	They dug up a huge amount of <b>clay</b> .
pray	Muslims <b>pray</b> in a mosque.
tray	Put the glasses on the <b>tray</b> .
stay	<b>Stay</b> there, do not move.
spray	<b>Spray</b> the room to freshen the air.
Monday	Do you look forward to work on a <b>Monday</b> ?
Friday	I'll shop for food on <b>Friday</b> .
always	My shoes are <b>always</b> shiny.
display	There was a <b>display</b> of books in the window.
