

## Spelling list: Prefixes: ante or anti? (copy)

These prefixes are often confused. Think about meanings: ante means before; anti means opposite .

anticlockwise	Run around the track in an <b>anticlockwise</b> direction.
anticlimax	I thought the end of the film was an <b>anticlimax</b> .
antiseptic	Mum put some <b>antiseptic</b> on his cut knee.
antidote	On the jungle trek they took an <b>antidote</b> to snake bites.
antisocial	Behaving rudely in public is <b>antisocial</b> .
antifreeze	Use <b>antifreeze</b> to protect the car's engine.
antenatal	Before the baby was born we went to <b>antenatal</b> classes.
antecedent	An <b>antecedent</b> is something that happened before.
anteroom	An <b>anteroom</b> leads to a larger, more important room.
