After the letters / and r the sound sh n is usually spelled *sion* .

compulsion	She felt a <b>compulsion</b> to break her promise.
convulsion	The patient experienced a major <b>convulsion</b> on the way to hospital.
emulsion	The room was painted in white <b>emulsion</b> paint.
expulsion	He was threatened with <b>expulsion</b> .
propulsion	The birds used their wings for <b>propulsion</b> .
version	I think the original <b>version</b> of this film was much better.
conversion	Do you know where to get the best <b>conversion</b> rates?
diversion	He pretended to feel unwell as a <b>diversion</b> while she sneaked into the classroom.
perversion	She was accused of <b>perversion</b> of the course of justice.
subversion	The actor's portrayal of the villain was a <b>subversion</b> of traditional archetypes.
excursion	The class went out on an <b>excursion</b> .
