

## Spelling list: Words ending in -ge (copy)

To spell the /j/ sound at the end of a word use **ge** .

cage	We keep our rabbit in a <b>cage</b> .
rage	She flew into a <b>rage</b> at the sight of the mess.
wage	After six months in the job I will get a <b>wage</b> increase.
huge	Disneyland is a <b>huge</b> theme park.
hinge	Put some oil on the <b>hinge</b> to stop it squeaking.
plunge	He was unsure whether to take the <b>plunge</b> .
large	Sam comes from a very <b>large</b> family.
merge	Click here to <b>merge</b> the two cells.
forge	A blacksmith works with metals in a <b>forge</b> .
gorge	The Grand Canyon is a huge <b>gorge</b> .
range	This shop stocks a great <b>range</b> of cheese.
change	Can you <b>change</b> a \$50 dollar bill?
strange	Did you hear that <b>strange</b> noise?
bulge	My stomach will <b>bulge</b> if I eat all that.
challenge	I <b>challenge</b> you to a game of chess.
arrange	Can we <b>arrange</b> a meeting?
exchange	I would like to <b>exchange</b> this dress for a smaller one.
revenge	When his friend was attacked Robert wanted <b>revenge</b> .
orange	Freshly squeezed <b>orange</b> juice tastes best.
