To spell the /j/ sound at the end of a word use **ge** .

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| cage | We keep our rabbit in a cage . |
| rage | She flew into a rage at the sight of the mess. |
| wage | After six months in the job I will get a wage increase. |
| huge | Disneyland is a huge theme park. |
| hinge | Put some oil on the hinge to stop it squeaking. |
| plunge | He was unsure whether to take the plunge . |
| large | Sam comes from a very large family. |
| merge | Click here to merge the two cells. |
| forge | A blacksmith works with metals in a forge . |
| gorge | The Grand Canyon is a huge gorge . |
| range | This shop stocks a great range of cheese. |
| change | Can you change a \$50 dollar bill? |
| strange | Did you hear that strange noise? |
| bulge | My stomach will bulge if I eat all that. |
| challenge | I challenge you to a game of chess. |
| arrange | Can we arrange a meeting? |
| exchange | I would like to exchange this dress for a smaller one. |
