## Spelling list: Words ending in -ce (copy)

The /s/ sound on the end of a word is sometimes spelled *ce*. Here are some examples.

lace	Fasten your shoe lace before you trip over.
pace	The race leader set a fast <b>pace</b> .
race	They rowed in the boat <b>race</b> .
grace	The dancer moved with great grace.
space	Is there enough <b>space</b> in the car for me?
nice	Leeks are <b>nice</b> in a stew.
rice	Chinese food is often served with boiled rice .
slice	Would you like a <b>slice</b> of cake?
spice	Use some ginger to <b>spice</b> up the curry.
price	Scan the bar code to find the <b>price</b> .
twice	I've been there <b>twice</b> .
voice	I've a sore throat and I've lost my <b>voice</b> .
choice	There's a <b>choice</b> of four desserts.
juice	Fruit <b>juice</b> is good for your health.
advice	The teacher gave me good <b>advice</b> .
device	A telephone is a very useful <b>device</b> .
entice	Can I entice you to have a slice of cream cake?
sacrifice	I will <b>sacrifice</b> my free time to do your work.
