

Spelling list: Words ending in *-nce* (copy)

On the end of a word the /s/ sound after the letter *n* is most often spelled *ce* .

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| chance | I have very little chance of winning. |
| glance | I've only had time to glance at your report. |
| stance | We will take a tough stance if our land is invaded. |
| advance | They planned the holiday well in advance . |
| instance | In this instance I will let you have the day off. |
| fence | The fence was made of wooden stakes. |
| commence | Shall we commence the game? |
| sentence | I was gripped by the very first sentence of this book. |
| mince | Beef mince can also be called ground beef. |
| prince | Charles is the Prince of Wales. |
| convince | I had to convince Jim that he was wrong. |
| once | I'll only tell you once . |
| ounce | One ounce is the same as 28.35 grams. |
| bounce | Don't bounce that ball near the window! |
| pounce | That cat is about to pounce on a bird. |
| announce | When will you announce the date? |
| pronounce | How do you pronounce your name? |
| France | Paris is the capital city of France . |
