

Spelling list: Words ending in *-ice* (copy)

On the end of a word of more than one syllable the /iss/ sound is usually spelled *ice* .

bodice	The bodice of her wedding dress fits perfectly.
hospice	We are raising funds to build a new hospice .
justice	The killer will be brought to justice .
lattice	A lattice is a criss-cross pattern.
malice	I did not feel any malice towards her.
novice	I am a complete novice at the game of darts.
office	I'll call your office to say you are sick.
practice	Top tennis players do hours of practice each day.
service	Call room service to order breakfast.
solstice	The summer solstice is the longest day of the year.
accomplice	The criminal and his accomplice were jailed.
apprentice	The plumbing company employed Jim as an apprentice .
precipice	A vertical cliff is a precipice .
prejudice	It is wrong to show prejudice against people who are different.
